Lesson Details (45 minutes total)				
Opening Routine Time:	To help create routine and sooth anxiety, every class should begin with the same activity. Consider creating an opening routine that allows students to move, incorporates rhythm, and invites students to offer something (a dance move, a clapped rhythm, a silly sound) that is repeated back by either just one other person or by the whole group.			
Warm Up Time: 5-7 mins	On a blank piece of paper, have students in five minutes write as many art classroom rules they can think of. If finished before five minutes, students can draw accompanying pictures			
Lesson Intro Time: 8-10 mins	On a large piece of paper or on the white board, go around the room and have a student give one class rule. Teacher will write these on the board or paper. After everyone has had a turn, add rules and expectations.			
Brain break Time:	Choose a brain break in the moment. Brain break used will determine whether the energy of the room becomes energized, calmed, or focused.			
Main Lesson Time: 20 mins	Students will construct their portfolios by folding and stapling poster board sheets and they will decorate them with markers, stickers, pencils, colored pencils, construction paper, glue, scissors			
Cool down/Closing Time:	Similar to the opening routine, your closing should be the sa way to signal the end of the class and transition to what com-		ach day as an expected
